


I BORGHI COLLECTION

I Borghi, the new collection of fabrics signed CTA® draws inspiration from enchanting countries where time seems to have stopped, medieval views, renaissance squares, superb baroque palaces, fortified citadels, places that have passed through stratifications unharmed, of different eras.

Each of these villages preserves small jewels, fortresses and castles where legends are staying.

A combination of history, nature and tradition that makes Italy an extraordinary country.

Created for those who like to recall the trends and spirit of our territories, the I Borghi collection will be able to give all the freshness and nuances of a surprisingly contemporary past.





BOSA



Bosa is a charming village located on the west coast of Sardinia. Considered one of the most beautiful villages in Italy, Bosa is famous for its picturesque historic center, the colourful houses overlooking the Temo river, and the medieval castle that dominates the city from above.

Bosa is born from the meeting of linen and polyester yarns. This combination gives the fabric two very positive qualities: the natural look of linen blend, but also the advantages of polyester in creating a stronger and more regular structure, ideal as a curtain in 65% LI 35% PL.

The added value of the **Bosa** is to be in width 345/350 cm. It is available in 13 color variations, delicate and elegant.

CAPALBIO



Capalbio is often called the "little Athens" for its cultural richness and lively atmosphere. It is one of the most beautiful villages in Tuscany, famous for its well-preserved medieval walls, breathtaking views of the Maremma countryside and its proximity to the Tyrrhenian coast.

The style of the colors and stripes recall the magical world of "Missoni".

Capalbio presents a printed design, made on a leno background in 89% PL 7% LI 4% VI. Its open weave combined with the double warp processing, creates a filtering curtain but at the same time able to create privacy. Ideal as a decorative curtain, it is proposed in three shades of multicolor. Available in width 298/305 cm finished with leadband.



DOLCEACQUA



Known for its picturesque charm, the suggestive medieval bridge and the castle overlooking the village, Dolceacqua is a charming medieval village located in Val Nervia, in Liguria.

The **Dolceacqua** fabric, proposed by CTA®, has a laminated print on a 100% LI made in the nuances of gold and silver printed on the art. Otranto in the natural and linen colour variant. The foil print has a width of about 295/300 cm.

Ideal as a decorative curtain, it is available in width 310/315 cm.

ERICE



Erice is a charming medieval village located on the top of Mount Erice, in Sicily.

With its cobbled streets, the breathtaking views of the west coast of Sicily and the atmosphere steeped in history and legends.

Erice gives the name to this curtain line, a mixed linen jacquard fil coupé made of 81% PL 19% LI.

The cutting of the yarns creates a particular three-dimensional effect of thick fringes aimed at recreating infinite rectangles.

Available in 5 shades of colours, white, natural, sand, ecru and bronze.

Available in width 300/305 cm finished with leadband.



FORTE



Carloforte is a picture sque village located on the island of San Pietro, of Ligurian origin.

It is the only inhabited town on the island and represents a unique destination thanks to its combination of cultural influences, maritime traditions and natural beauty.

The exclusivity of this village is the inspiration for the **Forte**, homonymous, modern and glamorous fabric line with a square structure that weaves opaque and shiny yarns, thick and thin, in 80% PL 20% LI.

It presents 17 color variations, in width 315/320 cm finished with eco-leadband.

OSTUNI



The most charming and picturesque village of Puglia, it looks like a cloud, known as the "White City", thanks to its white walls.

Here is a multiplication of floors, ups and downs, alleys and stairs, tangled streets that cross arches and squares.

The **Ostuni** curtain is made of 100% PL, a leno fabric made with a semi-glossy fine yarn, in 20 nuances that take up pastel and metallic colors.

The open weave gives it a lightness that makes it perfect for filtering light. The bright sight, light and soft touch.

Available in width 295/300 cm with eco-leadband.



OTRANTO



Otranto is famous for its ancient village, a town located in Puglia, on the Adriatic coast of Salento.

Also known as the "Porta d'Oriente", it is characterized by narrow and paved streets, medieval architecture, historic walls and a suggestive atmosphere.

Otranto fabric is 100% LI, whose appearance resembles jute canvas, with a soft and structured texture.

From natural white to sand, from linen color to dove, six nuances inspired by natural colors.

Made in width 298/305 cm.

ROCCA



Rocca Imperiale is a charming village located in Calabria, perched on the hill a few kilometers from the Ionian coast, it is known for its medieval old town, characterized by narrow streets, stone houses and picturesque views of the Ionian Sea.

The village takes its name from its imposing Rocca.

Coarse yarns are woven into thinner, shinier yarns. The result is a soft drape in 72% PL 28% Recycled PL, modern fabric with dense weave.

The **Rocca** fabric palette is developed in 23 nuances of metallic colors, ideal for modern architecture.

Available in width 310/315 cm.



TROPEA



The ancient village of Tropea is perched on a cliff overlooking the sea and offers breathtaking views of the coast and the Aeolian islands in the distance.

The old town is a tangle of historic buildings, squares and charming flowered balconies that give a unique character to the country.

Tropea, from the CTA® collection, recalls tradition thanks to the print on linen-blend background, 91% PL 9% LI. It is available in 3 multicolor variants in width 300/305 cm with eco-leadband.
